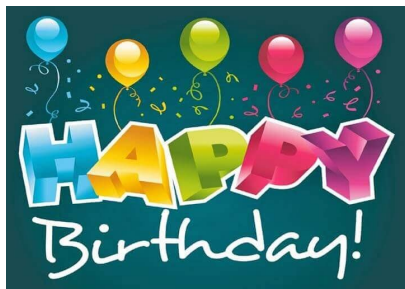
Paint Night February 11th at 5:30 p.m. Please make sure to sign up so we can plan on snacks and supplies. Bring a beverage there is snacks provided.

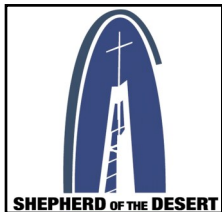
Ash Wednesday February 18th at 6:30 p.m. in the Sanctuary.
