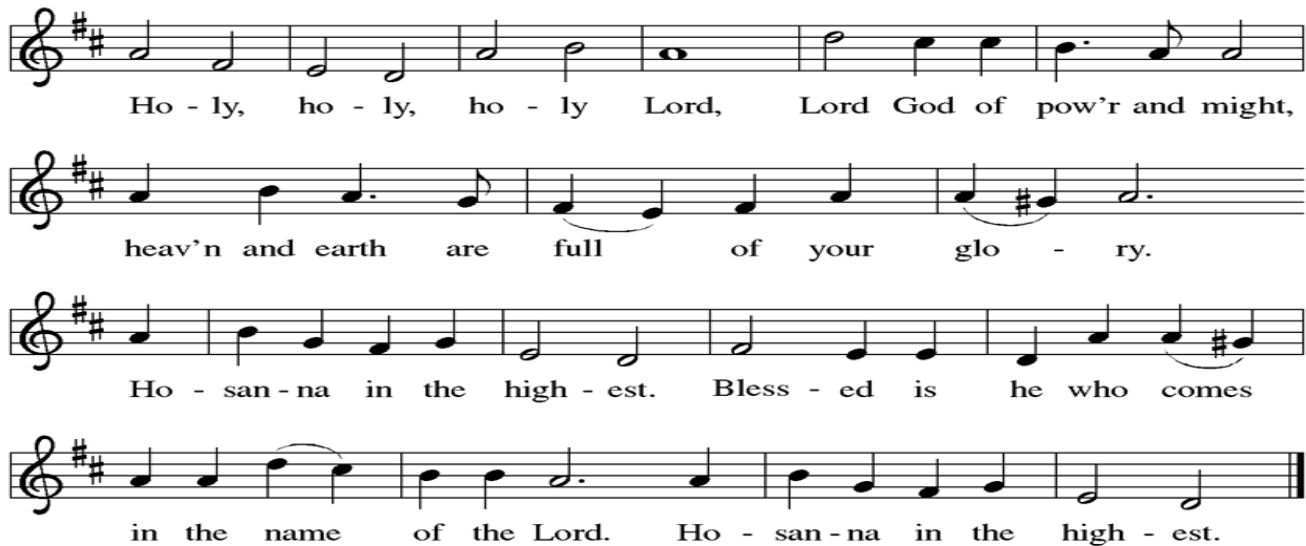

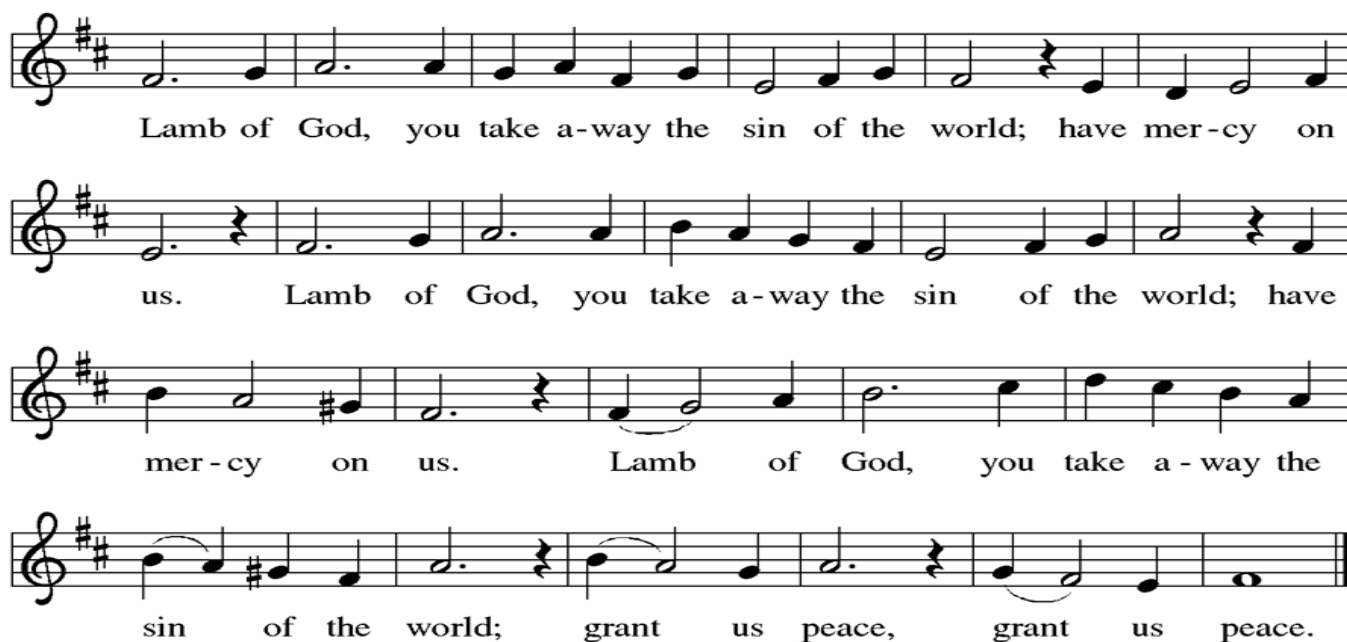

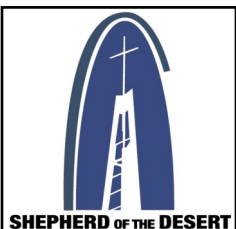
Shepherd of the Desert Announcements
